Training Itinerary -

Utah DPS Helicopter/High Angle – This course will have a High Angle Scenario in conjunction with the Utah DPS Helicopter. Please bring your Harness, Helmet, PAS (Personal Anchoring System) and other basic High Angle gear to this scenario. Classes will be limited by number. Sign up when you arrive. WCSSAR and DPS Aero Bureau

Medical Classes and Scenarios with the Utah National Guard: Physicians/Special Forces Medics – Basic Trauma Medicine, Long Term Field Care, Austere Environment Medicine - Wilderness, – Utah Army National Guard

Veterinarian Medicine: Dog and Pack Animal Care – Utah Army National Guard

Special Forces Maneuver: Land Navigation – Map and Compass, Introduction to Vehicle Recovery, Drone Operations – Utah Army National Guard

Public Safety Diver Underwater Skills Course – Bouyance Control, Navigation, Lifting objects, etc. - DPS Dive Team

High Angle High Line Course – How to properly set up and utilize a High Line in Rescue. For Intermediate and Advanced Rope Rescuers – Utah County Sheriff Search and Rescue

Pistol Shoot – Bring your own pistol and 50 rounds of ammo. Pistol shoot will be one course competition style with multiple targets at various distances and positions. - Deputy Paul and SAR Brady Argyle

SAR Rodeo Competition – SAR Teams of 4-5 competing in High Angle Skills, Medical Skills, Ground Skills, Water Skills, Etc. Awards for the winners....and maybe the losers.

Medical Techniques – Taught by MD's, PA's, Paramedics, Etc. No medical certification is needed. For all who are looking to improve their skills.

SAR K-9's Cadaver and Tracking – This course will introduce you to K-9 capabilities, Cadaver and Tracking. Classroom and Field Work. SAR K-9 – Deputy Mitton/K-9 Scout, Deputy Montgomery.

Man Tracking – Introduction to Man Tracking, identifying tracks, methods of picking up a trail, scene safety, direction of travel, stride length, and what not to do. Mohave County SAR

Underwater Drones – Capabilities, operations, recording and documentation, techniques in picking up items, power and depth limitations. This is an in water practical course.

Surface Water Rescue – In water surface rescue skills utilizing Zodiac style boats.

Utah Sheriff's Ride - Ride Location to be determined – Meet at SH Maint. Bldg 0800 Saturday.
